
<u>Every good ... gift</u> is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights. James 1:17 (NIV)



#### GOOD GIFTS TO THE HUNGRY AND MALNOURISHED

Porch distributed protein-rich, fortified *MannaPack* rice to 160 families in the remote *Boca Costa* region. Chronic malnutrition is rampant there, especially among children.

This rice was part of the 28,500pound shipment we received recently. A generous Porch mission partner funded the \$1300 product cost (Gracias!). Your generous donations have helped keep our staff employed during the pandemic, even without short-term teams.

They also pay for the distribution costs (for example, diesel) of this rice and more.
