


#### PORCH'S NOVEMBER TEAMS

Samuel (above left and middle) was chained to a post for years due to severe schizophrenia. Jayne Mittan, our medical liaison who brought gifts and attended to Samuel shared, "Samuel is now safe, being fed, clothed, sheltered, cared for, and getting his medicine every day. When we found him, he was none of those things. He is no longer having the violent outbursts that got him chained up. While he will never be "normal," he is much better off than when we found him. He is treated as a human being with a serious mental illness, not seen as someone who is possessed and feared."

Porch de Salomon also hosted a vision clinic in Panajachel. Yasmine (above right) and many others left with a smile on their face. Three hundred and twenty people with restored vision!

#### Porch de Salomon congratulates our 2022 scholarship high school graduates!

In Guatemala, over 50% of indigenous teenagers have not completed third grade. On average, indigenous Guatemalan women have only 3.5 years of school. Grinding poverty is the predominant cause of this problem; families cannot afford school as they struggle to put food on the table daily.
