In February, Porch de Salomon hosted doctors, dentists, nurses, and pharmacists who gave their expertise and resources to host medical, dental, and eye clinics in indigenous communities. In rural Guatemala, access to general healthcare and dental care is often non-existent and can lead to many health issues.



During February, the general medicine doctors served 998 patients, the dentists relieved 135 patients of pain, and the vision clinic restored vision to 270 patients. We thank God for the provisions that have come through the gifted hands of team Sequoyah Hills and 4TZ!
